"Music changes lives and the guitar is such a powerful tool. Music is healing and allows you to express your stories and brings joy," says Cade. "I give back to homeless shelters because it's part of my story, my family has been homeless as well."

Cade's "Giving Guitars Tour" in partnership with Brent Yates and The Gravity of Up visits shelters and agencies across the country that offer housing and services to homeless families and those in need. To date, Cade has visited more than 40 homeless shelters in 11 different

states and has gifted over 70 guitars to the residents of these shelters.
